The NAWADES project is full of progress!

In order to measure the progress achieved by the coordinators at the end of the R&D Work Packages, the NAWADES team will meet this week in Barcelona.

With the participation of 11 institutions from 6 different countries, the project, coordinated by Fraunhofer Institute for Interfacial Engineering and Biotechnology (IGB), is developing a membrane system for seawater desalination. The technology shall provide long life and antifouling filters to be used in Reverse Osmosis (RO) water desalination processes with a higher efficiency and life-time, less energy consumption (lower pressure) and less maintenance (lower cost).

The meeting will offer the occasion to the team to visit the desalination plant built in El Prat de Llobregat, close to Barcelona. The Catalan Water Agency (Agència Catalana de l'Aigua -ACA-) could collaborate with the NAWADES team providing, by the end of the year, the authorization for using a space in the building to install a pilot plant in order to test NAWADES technology during one year and half.
